- 2 A copy of your risk assessment, public liability insurance, and food hygiene certificates (if applicable) must accompany this application. If you are unsure about any of these please contact us, we will be pleased to help in any way we can.
- 3 We only accept traders of the highest quality, who will reflect the type of events we produce. "Auctioneers", PA's/amplification, hawking and peddling are strictly forbidden.
- 4 Stalls will be supervised by the appointed official who is responsible for maintaining quality and you must agree to follow their instructions. You may be asked to remove from display items which are not on the agreed list. You may also be asked to dismantle or secure any unsafe structures. In extreme cases, the appointed official has the authority to revoke your license to trade and ask you to leave the site.
- 5 This event is staged outdoors and stallholders must be responsible for providing their own tables, chairs and gazebos.
- 6 Vehicles are allowed on site only for settings up and striking. All vehicles must be removed immediately after setting up. No vehicles will be allowed to return to their pitch site until after the event closing time.
- 7 Stalls with food and drink items are limited. Please specify if you intend to sell any food or drink in the section 'Nature of Business'.
- 8 Using offensive or abusive language towards anyone will forfeit your license to trade at this event.
